



## Refund Policy



Following evaluations and team selection, players will be assigned to teams. Once a player has accepted a place on a team and registered with Tormenta FC Academy, he or she will not be eligible for a refund. Special circumstances may warrant a refund to include season ending injury or relocation. Refund amounts will be based on a sliding scale. According to US Youth Soccer rules, players who have made a financial commitment to a club are considered registered to that club for the seasonal year as of July 1. A player cannot be released from a club until all financial obligations have been satisfied. If a player chooses to leave the club before the end of the soccer year, all club and team fees must be paid in full for the entire soccer calendar year- fall and spring seasons. Any request for a refund or release of financial obligation must be approved by the club Vice-President.
